# **ONE COAT DAMP SEAL**

Thompson's One Coat Damp Seal permanently covers damp, water and other household stains in one coat. It can be applied directly onto damp walls and ceilings.

#### **COMPOSITION**

Thompson's One Coat Damp Seal is a low odour, solvent based, highly pigmented, acrylic system.

#### **PROPERTIES**

Viscosity - Viscous liquid. VOC Content – Very High (>50% w/v). Odour – Low solvent type. Solubility – Immiscible with water.

#### **AREAS OF APPLICATION**

Interior walls and ceilings.

#### PREPARATION

It's important to make sure the cause of damp has been rectified before painting, otherwise it'll just come back. Open doors & windows to make sure the room is well ventilated. Remove any wallpaper and flaking paint with a damp cloth. Fill any cracks or holes, if needed. You can apply this onto damp surfaces, just make sure they're not dripping wet.

#### APPLICATION

Give the tin a really good stir. Apply with a brush or roller. Apply the paint over the affected area, plus about 30cm around it.

#### COVERAGE

Thompson's One Coat Damp Seal will cover  $5m^2$  per litre.

Coverage will depend on the texuture & type of surface you're coating.

#### **DRYING TIME**

Allow to dry for 4 hours before decorating over. Dry times will vary depending on the texture & type of surface you're coating.

#### **CLEANING OF TOOLS**

All equipment should be cleaned immediately after use with white spirit or brush cleaner.

Remove as much product as possible from equipment before washing.

#### MAINTENANCE

Further applications of Thompson's One Coat Damp Seal should not be necessary. If staining reoccurs, the source of the damp has not been correctly rectified.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES**

Always read the instructions carefully before use.

#### STORAGE

Store in a cool, well ventilated place away from heat and sources of ignition. Store upright and carefully reseal partly used containers.

The shelf life of the product in airtight containers is at least 3 years.

To avoid risk of spillage, always store and transport in a secure and upright position.

#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

Observe and follow all warnings and instructions for use shown on the pack.
